Transit in Paris: the travelling WONDERLAND exhibition will be stored at the maison de l'architecture from June 1st to June 10th, 2005. Following Prague, Bratislava, Berlin, and Amsterdam, the French edition has undertaken the task to recount this traveling and evolving adventure. Having assembled 66 different European offices until today, WONDERLAND is an invitation to browse a pixelated mosaic that adds up to a catalogue of projects, experiments, and attitudes, affording a look across the scene of contemporary and emergent architectural practices.

Collaborations – transient or transforming ?

The Age and Generation of Collaboration ?

The thematic proposal by Wonderland for the PARIS workshops has been described with the two terms 'mobility / beyond Europe' which questions the potentialities and options for the emerging generation of architects within Europe and beyond, in changing and transforming areas (especially Asia and Latin America, parts of Africa) regarding the social and economical context. And it raises the issue of crossregional and transnational/continental collaborations and its effects.

Content

The issues to be discussed, not only in an abstract sense, but on the basis on the actual experience and demand of the different Wonderland teams may be:

- Is there a gap between those who run offices in different countries, actively cultivate international contacts and running crossregional and transnational/continental collaborations and those who solely act on local level?
- Which synergies and solutions bear the conjunction of different approaches?
- Which impact does collaboration have on the project's conceptions and design?
- Which organisational project implications and hurdles have to be mastered?
- And more generally, how can communication and actual collaboration open up our minds to new approaches?

We thought of focussing 2 thematic strands of the collaboration issue

1. Crossregional, transnational/continental collaborations and projects

Exploring the experience, demands, possibilities and aspirations

Proposed workshop leaders: **coloco**, Paris and **K-architectures**, Paris

2. Wonderland as a collaboration pool and project generating tool

Not only the exhibition design of Wonderland in Paris, quasi marking the median of the project (5th of its 9 stations) stands for the process of transition and transformation in the sense of added value, also this workshop focus intends to explore the transformation of the Wonderland architects network in terms of additional layers, of further activities, of collaboration potentials among participants and beyond. Several plantlets of collaboration projects and ideas have already seen the light of the day, so let's bring the one or other to prosper and flourish.
